This World Refill Day on June 16th, we're inviting you to join the 5 Day Challenge – a fun, easy and impactful way to try new ways to ditch disposables and embrace reuse in everyday life.

Whether you're the leader of an NGO, a business owner, a content creator, a family on the go or just getting started on your sustainability journey – this challenge is for YOU.

What is it?

It's simple: from Monday 16 June to Friday 20 June, take part in an impactful challenge to reduce single-use waste.

Choose a new swap each day or stick with one that works for you – Whether it's refilling your coffee cup, reusing containers for takeaways, or shopping packaging-free options – every swap counts.

You can take part solo, with your team, your followers, your school, your kids – anyone!





Sounds great. How does it work?

Step 1: Pick your swap(s)

Choose one thing to do for 5 days or try a new thing each day.
We've included a list of ideas below to get you started.

Step 2: Download the Refill Return App

Find places near you to top up your water bottle, refill your coffee cup, and use packaging-free options in stores.

Available for free on iOS and Android.

Step 3: Share your swaps

Post your progress using #5DayChallenge, #WorldRefillDay and #MoreThanYouThink. Tag us @Refillhq to join the movement!

Step 4: Inspire others

Encourage your community to take part. Whether you've got 10 followers or 10,000 – your voice makes a difference.

Step 5: Celebrate your impact

Every action counts.

Together, we're building a future beyond disposables.





- Order your hot drink in your reusable coffee cup if you have one (ask if there's a special discount for reusables win win!)
- Having takeaways for lunch? Ask the restaurant to put it in your own box.
- Date night plans? Bring your own box for leftover food without unnecessary single-use.
- **Rethink your bathroom** Try refillable options in supermarket to refill laundry detergent, soap or shampoo.
- Empty containers stacking up in your cupboard, or filling your bin? Return your empties to be reused: return your empty jars or eggboxes to a zero-waste shop, return your plant pots to the nursery or return your clothes to a charity shop to be reused.
- **Pick online** products in bulk to refill at home: like those 10Ltr dishwasher liquid, refillable deodorant, weekly milk delivery.
- Borrow a cup for your takeaway coffee there are 30 returnable cup schemes on the app.
- Say no to plastic water bottles refill on the go.




































Top tips for success

What if I forget one day or slip up?

No worries at all - progress, not perfection!

Do I need to download the Refill App?

It's not essential, but it's super helpful.

The free Refill app helps you find over 400,000 locations globally where you can refill water bottles, coffee cups, lunchboxes and more – on the go and without the waste.

What if I don't have any reusable items yet?

Start where you are. Use what you've got.

Even an old jar can become a coffee cup, and tupperware works for takeaway! We'll be sharing lots of affordable and creative tips during the challenge week too.

Can I do this with friends, colleagues or family?

Absolutely - the more, the better!

Start a group chat, set a team goal, or challenge your workplace to go single-use-free for 5 days. Every conversation helps grow the movement.

Can I get featured by Refill or City to Sea?

Yes! We're looking out for standout stories, reels, and creative ideas!

Make sure to tag us and use the hashtags so we can find and share your content across our channels!

Why does this matter, really?

Every minute, a truckload of plastic ends up in our oceans. Most of it is used once and thrown away. By choosing to reuse – even just for 5 days – you're showing that there's a better way. And if enough of us do it we can spark real change.



Nearly HALF of the plastic created goes into packaging that's single-use. Only 9% of that is known to be recycled.

UK households are throwing away 1.7 billion pieces of plastic each week.**

Why it matters

We could save more than **7 Million pieces of single-use** if only 5% of UK homes took part in this challenge.

72%* of people want to see more reusable, refillable and returnable options where they shop.


if just 1 in 10 people got their takeaway coffee in a reusable rather than single-use cup for 5 days, we could save nearly 3.5 Million single-use cups, and that's just in the UK!

1 in 4* say lack of encouragement from family/friends has made them stop a sustainable initiative in the last 12months. World Refill Day is the perfect opportunity to normalise the reuse behaviours.
